The following were the only questions received.

Q1: Can companies from Outside USA apply for this?

A1: Companies from outside the USA can offer responses to this RFQQ but the work needs to be done in the USA. We work with many communities across Washington State to digitize their newspapers, many of which are unique, original materials owned by small historical organizations and libraries. Due to the rare nature of these materials, we note, in the introduction section of this proposal, that we will not ship these materials out of the U.S.

Due to our restrictions on shipping rare and original materials, scanning should be done within the continental U.S.

Q2: Whether we need to come over there for meetings?

A1: we conduct our work via phone and online communications.

Q3: Can we perform the tasks outside USA? (like, from India or Canada)
